Dear Parent or Guardian:

As required under the No Child Left Behind Act, the district is providing notice about the Supplemental Education Services Program. This program offers academic enrichment instruction by State approved agencies within our locality. The purpose of the program is to help our middle and high school students further succeed at school. Services include after-school tutoring. Services are free and are based upon a federal allocation available to your child.

Interested parents are permitted to select an approved supplemental educational service provider for their child. Students are eligible for these services if they qualify for a free or reduced lunch. Your child's candidacy must be first confirmed through the district's Office of Programs & Pupil Services at 629-3202. Upon approval, it is the parent's responsibility to select and make arrangements with the provider. Should you wish, the Office of Programs & Pupil Services is available to help you make your selection.

If your child qualifies for free or reduced lunch prices or your family meets other economic criteria, you are encouraged to consider this program for your child. A complete listing is available on the New York State Department of Education's website <http://emsc.nysed.gov>.

Again, we encourage you to consider this program for your child and apply for this program before March 1, 2008.
