The district has also created and is implementing our CEP plan, as required. This plan is focused on creating district wide improvement on both ELA and Math scores within the special education sub group and our entire student population. The school improvement team has identified our elementary and middle school math achievement as an area of vulnerability and has allocated resources to this area to avoid falling below our AYP in future years.
