## **Program Overview**

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND?**

Any student from grades 7 through grade 12 who is currently attending any public, private or parochial school may attend the Watervliet summer school program. Permission by a school official will be required to register.

### **ATTENDANCE**

Students who exceed 2 unexcused absences over the six week program will not receive credit for their course(s). If a student is absent, he/she must present (to the attendance office) a note from their parent explaining the student's absence, within 3 school days.

### **EXPECTATIONS:**

Students are expected to attend all scheduled days of instruction. Students are expected to be on time to their classes. Any student that is more than 5 minutes late to class will not be allowed to attend that class until the next school day. Students are expected to dress appropriately according to the Watervliet Jr./Sr. High school Discipline Code. Students will be expected to keep all electronic devices (including, cell phones, i-pods, video games, etc.) put away where they are not visually accessible and turned off during school hours.

### **REGISTRATION INFORMATION:**

The summer school registration will take place in the Junior/Senior High school lobby on June 30 and July 1 from 8:30 A.M. through 1:00 P.M. Registration forms are available in the Guidance office.
