# **SUPPLIES**

Math - One 2 inch binder, 5 dividers, loose-leaf paper, Graph paper, 1 spiral notebook, pens, pencils (suggest: scientific calculator (Texas Instrument 30XA)

Adv. Math - Same as math

**English - Composition notebook** 

Social Studies - One 3-subject notebook with pockets, pens (black or blue only), pencils, colored pencils (24 count), loose-leaf paper

Science - One 2 inch binder, Marble composition book (for Science Glossary – stays in the classroom), highlighter, colored pencils

Foreign Language - 1 binder, loose-leaf paper, dividers (for Spanish) and pen or pencil

Art - Pencils and erasers

Technology - 1 notebook and a pack of pencils

Health - Notebook or 1 inch binder with loose-leaf paper, and bring a pen every day to class

Home & Careers - Loose-leaf paper, pens and pencils

PE - Change of clothes: T-shirt or sweatshirt, shorts or sweatpants, sneakers and deodorant (no aerosol spray cans)

### **IDEAS**:

If you have already purchased supplies that are different than on the supply list, do not worry these are suggested items. If possible, purchase binders/notebooks that are different colors to make locating items in locker easier.

• Please put student's name on the outside of notebooks, binders and folders in case he or she misplaces these items.

Current  $7^{\text{th}}$  grade students have found that backpacks with wheels will not fit into the  $7^{\text{th}}$  grade lockers. The width of the locker is  $11 \frac{1}{2}$  inches and the depth is  $10 \frac{1}{2}$  inches, but the door opening is only  $8 \frac{1}{2}$  inches wide.

Locker shelves are great for keeping the locker organized. If purchasing one, please look for shelves that are tall enough to stand textbooks upright underneath it.
